CAUTIONARY NOTES

- 1 Congested area with pedestrians, dogs and bicycles.
- 2 Steep hill, may need to walk bike 200 yards up hill.
- 3 Trail cuts through parking lot which may be congested with motor vehicle and boat trailer traffic.
- 4 Motor vehicles share portion of route or part of route is on roadway.
- 5 Rail road crossing, use caution. Cross tracks at a 90 degree angle.
- 6 Illegal to ride bicycle on sidewalks of Blue Bridge, Main Street, D Street and in between these streets.
- 7 Route crosses busy road with commercial truck traffic.
- 8 Bicycles need to be carried up or down nine steps, wheeling ramp available for going up stairs.
- 9 Route uses a sidewalk where northbound travel is toward oncoming traffic.

- 1 Times calculated assuming leisurely 5 MPH pace.
- 2 Water on Levee Trail above Kiwanis Park, in Kiwanis Park by restrooms, & Mt. Dew Skate Park. Restrooms in Kiwanis Park and at Southway Boat Launch.
- 3 Water/restrooms in USACOE and boat launch.
- 4 Water/restrooms at Chestnut Beach.
- 5 Water/restrooms at Lewis & Clark Discovery Center and various locations throughout Park.
- 6 Water/restrooms in Downtown Lewiston businesses.
- 7 Water/restrooms at Lewis & Clark Interpretive Center.
- 8 Water/restrooms at Swallows Nest Park and Boat Ramp.
- 9 Water/restrooms at Clearwater River Interpretive Center.
- 10 Water at Trail/Riverview Drive intersection. Water/restrooms in Downtown Clarkston businesses.
- 11 Water/restrooms 1 mile east of Memorial Bridge.

PORT OF CLARKSTON connects the Clarkston Cruise Dock (A) to the United States Army Corps of Engineers Clarkston Natural Resource Office (B). This route offers views of the confluence of Snake and Clearwater rivers. Look across the Snake River towards Lewiston to see the Canoe Wave sculpture and Confluence mural.

CLARKSTON GREENBELT connects (B) the United States Army Corps of Engineers Clarkston Natural Resource Office connecting with intersection (C) at the base of the Southway Bridge.

DOWNTOWN CLARKSTON is accessed from point (N) near the Interstate (Blue) Bridge by traveling up the paved unmarked trail to Riverview Boulevard. Turn left onto Riverview Boulevard, follow to Sycamore Street, turn right and continuing to 6th Street (P).

SWALLOWS ROCK/ASOTIN connects (C) Southway Bridge to (M) downtown Asotin. The route meanders through Swallows Park and

passes near Snake River Office of Hells Canyon National Recreational Area. Swallows Rock's vertical Basalt cliffs loom 400' overhead. Look for nesting cliff swallows and other cliff dwelling birds. The route crosses Highway 129 just prior to the Asotin Creek bridge. Baumeister Drive/Asotin Creek Drive connect with 2nd Street leading into downtown Asotin (M).

SOUTHWAY BRIDGE connects (C) Southway Bridge by taking the paved trail up a steep switchback path to the pedestrian walkway over the Snake River, then down to intersection (D). Enjoy panoramic views from this elevated perch high above the Snake River.

Announce when overtaking from behind, "bicycle on your left," slow and be prepared to stop for unexpected reactions.

HELLS GATE STATE PARK connects (D) the Idaho side of Southway (Concrete) Bridge with the Lewis Clark Discovery Center at Hells Gate State Park (E). The Center is less than one mile past the park boundary which is marked by a sign indicating entry into the park. The bicycle/pedestrian path passes through a marina and parking area at the boat launch, then crossing Hells Gate Road. The Lewis Clark Discovery Center (E) is just 100 yards down the main road from this crossing point, or follow the path past the Center to access camping, beach and picnic areas.

LEWISTON LEVEE connects (D) the Idaho side of Southway (Concrete) Bridge with the (F) Idaho side of Interstate (Blue) Bridge. This route follows the banks of the Snake River passing through locally popular Kiwanis Park.

INTERSTATE BRIDGE connects (B) the Washington side of the Snake River to (F) the Idaho side of the river. From (B) United States Army Corps of Engineers Natural Resource Office, travel through parking lot to base of paved one-way entry road. Stay to left, using sidewalk at top of hill. Proceed across Snake River using pedestrian walkway into Idaho. Utilize stairs on Idaho side of bridge (F).

CONFLUENCE connects (F) the Idaho side of Interstate (Blue) Bridge to (G) the 5th Street pedestrian bridge. This short route includes Lewis and Clark Interpretive Center and Tscemicinum (meeting of the waters) sculpture. The D Street pedestrian bridge provides access to parking facilities and restroom.

DOWNTOWN LEWISTON connects (G) the 5th Street pedestrian bridge with downtown Lewiston. The 5th Street pedestrian bridge is adorned with artist Melissa Cole's mosaic featuring colorfully tiled salmon and snake. The route ends at the Lewiston City Library (H) offering access to the Historic Downtown Lewiston.

CLEARWATER RIVER connects (G) the 5th Street pedestrian bridge with (J) the Clearwater River levee behind Hahn Supply. This route follows the banks of the historically significant Clearwater River, passing by Clearwater Landing Interpretive Center.

LOCOMOTIVE PARK is accessed from (J) behind Hahn Supply via a narrow street leading to (L) Locomotive Park, the site of Lewiston's famous "Winter Spirit" Christmas display using over a half-million lights! In summertime enjoy car shows and other events.

RED LION HOTEL connects the Red Lion Hotel (K) with (J) behind Hahn Supply on the Clearwater River. From hotel parking lot, head downhill and past El Sombrero Mexican Restaurant. At the restaurant, use crosswalk to access sidewalk on opposite side of Main Street. Using sidewalk proceed to 23rd Street, follow to Railroad Avenue. Continue underneath the Clearwater River Memorial Bridge (Hwy 12) connecting with (J) the Clearwater River route.

NORTH LEWISTON connects Locomotive Park (L) with the north side of the Clearwater River via the Memorial Bridge (Hwy 12). A path leads through Locomotive Park, crossing the bridge using a sidewalk on the west side of the bridge. Immediately at the north end of Memorial Bridge, a side path connects to the recreation trail next to the river. The trail ends south of the Clearwater Casino, where riders proceeding east merge onto Hwy 95/12 (Q).

You'll find unique bike racks that double as art throughout the downtown corridor.

Mountain biking enthusiasts can enjoy miles of dirt trails in Hells Gate State Park and the attached trail system. With views of the Snake River and nearby Craig Mountains, it's a scenic and peaceful place to escape people and traffic.

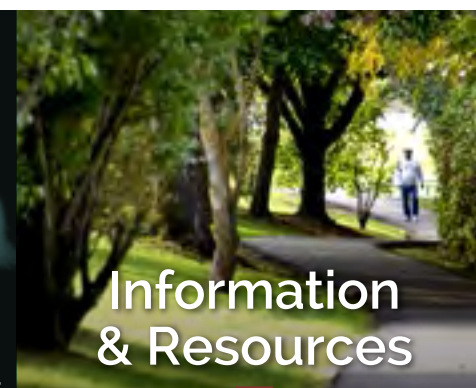
