1 The Lewis Clark Valley wine-growing region is part of the new (and old) frontier in the wine industry.

The Lewis Clark Valley, consisting of Lewiston, Idaho and Clarkston, Washington, is known as the “Banana Belt” of the Pacific Northwest because of its mild climate which allows for year-round recreational activities. It also allows for excellent wine-grape growing capabilities.

Our wine history started in 1872 when grapes were first introduced to the Clearwater Valley by three Europeans. Through their efforts the region became known for its wine. Prohibition in the 1920's & 30's hurt the industry and it didn't see a resurgence until the early part of this century with Clearwater Canyon Cellars in Lewiston, ID, Basalt Cellars Winery in Clarkston, WA, and Colter's Creek Vineyard in nearby Juliaetta, ID planting varietals in their fledgling vineyards. Lindsay Creek Vineyard began their viticulture venture in 2007 and will be followed by Vine 46 with anticipated sales in early 2016.
