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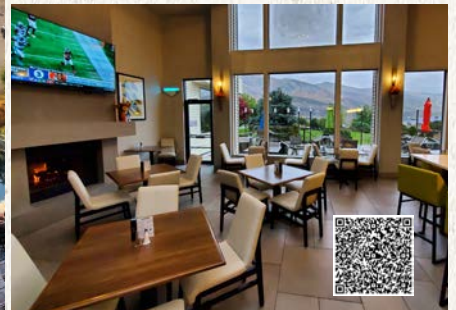

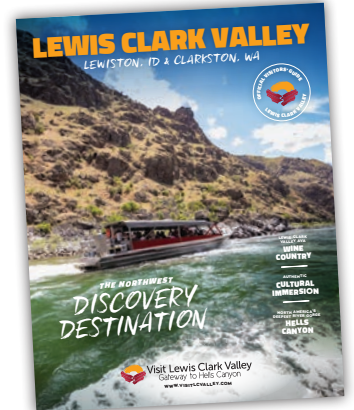

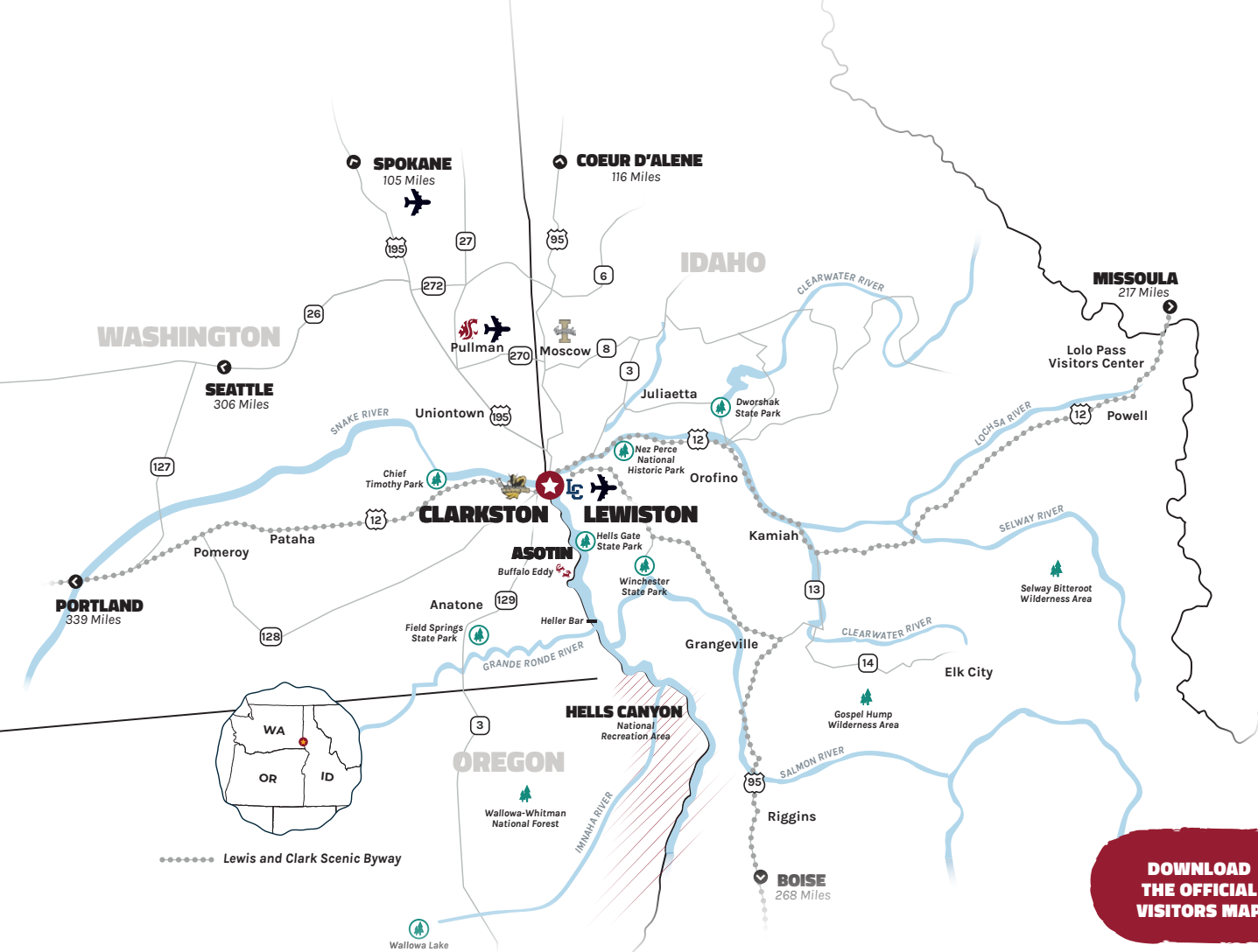

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ABSOLUTELY AUTHENTIC

As we walked through the rows of vines, wine glasses in hand, I had a “We’re not in Kansas anymore” moment. The Idaho Century Farm that is home to **Clearwater Canyon Cellars** provides glimpses between the grapes of soft, rounded bronze hills in the distance. Above them, cerulean skies populated by transient white clouds and a warming late autumn sun were all contributing to a perfect wine country afternoon. But this was not a wine region I was familiar with. Varietals like Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec and Carmenère were all worthy and welcome palate pleasers, but again, not what I was accustomed to. We were also the only ones there. My friends and I exchanged wry smiles and knowing nods. After all, this was exactly what we were looking for and precisely why we chose the Lewis Clark Valley.

After completing the tour of the vineyard at Clearwater Canyon Cellars, co-owner/winemaker, Coco, gave us a remarkably engrossing lesson in the soil, geology, climate and science of the Northwest’s newest American Viticultural Area. Samples were finished, purchases were made and we loaded back into the van, ready for our next destination. At the recommendation of nearly anybody I could ask, we booked a tour with **Twisted Vine Wine Tours** to get a good lay of the land—and secure a designated driver. This decision made me a hero within the group. Clint, the owner/tour guide, was a goldmine of knowledge and affable professionalism. And our final destination on the tour, **Lindsay Creek Vineyards**, was an excellent choice. All the stops were wonderful—cozy tasting rooms, boutique wineries, and now with Lindsay Creek, a sprawling estate with the capacity to host weddings, live music and any number of other events.

After the tour, we enjoyed some down time in our respective rooms at our home for the weekend, the **Hells Canyon Grand**, before freshening up and meeting for dinner on-site. Another recommendation that panned out in our favor, **Meriwether’s Bistro** resides within the hotel and wound up being the perfect marriage of convenience and farm-fresh Northwest cuisine. Emboldened by full bellies, we headed

over to the **Clearwater River Casino & Event Center** for drinks and a show. I have an affinity for Northwest casinos. Having lived in Vegas for five years, I got my fill of the mega-casinos and the lavish trappings that are their hallmarks. Up here, casinos feel more like cozy lodges, often providing tangible tribal history in addition to gaming and entertainment. After taking in some Nez Perce history, it was time to pay homage to more recent and personal history in the form of a concert. I still maintain that the 90s were a golden age for music, and that evening only helped bolster my claim.

Having pumped the breaks on the evening before things got overly-festive, we woke the next morning fairly spry, but certainly in need of some morning-after nutrition. Breakfast at **Main Street Grill** helped normalize my faculties through a dish known as Garbage Browns. It's exactly what you think it is—kitchen sink-style hashbrowns—and it was everything I needed at that moment.

Next, we opted for a little scenery and excitement in the form of a jet boat tour with **Snake River Adventures**. The Snake River flows in serpentine fashion through Hells Canyon—the deepest river gorge in North America. The jet boats have a long and storied history, but beyond that, they are a hell of a fun way to explore Hells Canyon. The ride is often fast, occasionally wet if you're in the right spot, and always exciting.

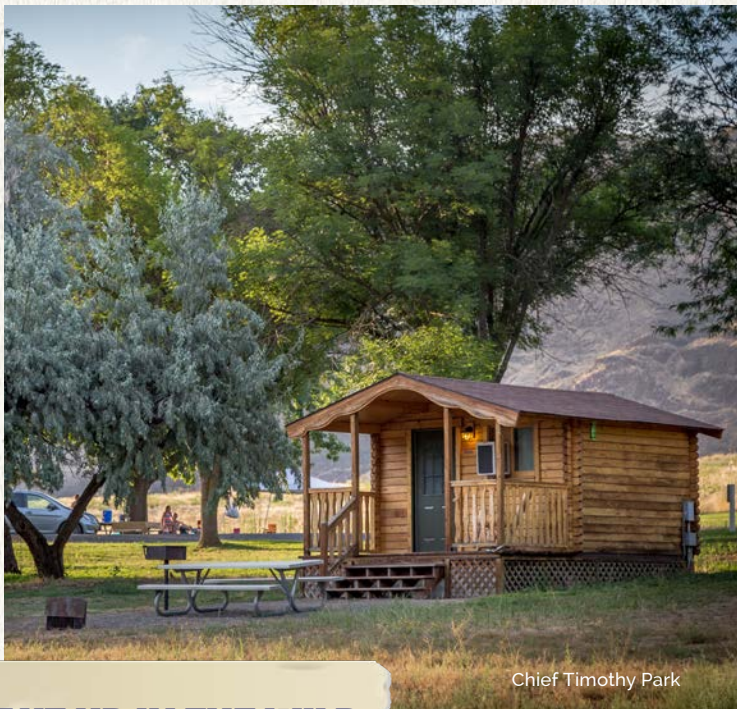
Last supper was at the **Mystic Café**—a local institution that is equal parts saloon and coffee shop. I finished strong with a bone-in ribeye and a glass of Malbec. We would all retire somewhat early that night, sleep well and head home in the morning.

A wine weekend in the Lewis Clark Valley is unlike any other in the Northwest. In some ways, it's akin to what those suddenly renowned areas must have been like 10 or 20 years ago. It is undiscovered and absolutely authentic. The hipster in me hopes it stays that way. The wine lover in me is happy it's there, and more than happy to share.

WAKE UP IN THE WILD

This full-service, family-friendly campground is known for its welcoming vibe — think cornhole tournaments, holiday popsicles, and even trick-or-treating in October.

Just downstream, **Hells Gate State Park** (5100 Hells Gate Rd., Lewiston, ID; 208.799.5015; parksandrecreation.idaho.gov/parks/hells-gate) offers riverside camping with modern amenities, cozy cabins, warm showers, picnic areas, and a marina. Once home to a Nez Perce village, today it's a hub for outdoor recreation and live summer events.

Pro tip: Buy firewood locally to help prevent the spread of invasive species.

CONNECT WITH THE NIMIIPUU

A visit to **Nez Perce National Historical Park** (Spalding, ID, 10 miles east of Lewiston; 208.843.7001; nps.gov/nepe) is a meaningful way to experience the living culture of the Nimiipuu. Explore exhibits, watch an inspiring film, and walk short interpretive trails along the Clearwater River. Kids can dive into the Junior Ranger program, complete with scavenger hunts and language activities.

Deepen your experience and saddle up with the Nimiipuu Appaloosa Horseback Riding Experience through **Nez Perce Tourism** (800 Main Ste. 2, Lewiston, ID; 208.790.8873; nezpercetourism.com). Guided by knowledgeable wranglers, riders learn the rich history of the Tribe's horse culture and the powerful connection to the Appaloosa — a breed developed by the Nimiipuu and recognized around the world.

Pro tip: Visit in spring or fall to witness salmon spawning along Lapwai Creek — a remarkable natural spectacle.

TEE UP WITH A GOLF GETAWAY

Nestled within the embrace of the Inland Northwest lies a golfer's paradise with a unique moniker – the "Banana Belt" of the Lewis Clark Valley. As winter blankets the surrounding regions with snow and frost, this mild climate haven ensures that golf enthusiasts can pursue their passion year-round. The valley proudly boasts four 18-hole courses, offering a rendezvous with nature's beauty and challenging landscapes.

RED WOLF GOLF CLUB

Leading the charge is the illustrious **Red Wolf Golf Club** (1676 Elm St., Clarkston, WA; redwolfgolfclub.com; 509.758.2546), a riverside gem where the fairways unfold against breathtaking river and valley views. The course, stretching between 5,400 to 6,700 yards, unfolds as a masterpiece of classic tree-lined fairways, complemented by the presence of four shimmering ponds on 8 holes and a strategic array of bunkers. Renowned for having the fastest greens in the region, Red Wolf Golf Club stands as a testament to precision and skill, drawing golfers seeking both challenge and tranquility.

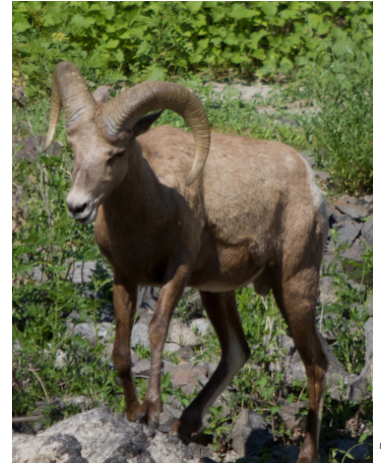

From ancient tribal legends to the significant Lewis-Clark Expedition, the roots of this land run deep, creating a canvas that tells stories of the Nimiipuu, the Nez Perce people, and the explorers who shaped its destiny.

THE LEGACY OF THE NIMIIPUU: A CULTURAL JOURNEY

According to tribal legend, the Nimiipuu, or "the people," were created in this very region over 11,000 years ago. The Nez Perce, as they are known, played a pivotal role in the Lewis-Clark Expedition, providing life-saving assistance to explorers Lewis and Clark. Today, the Nez Perce National Historical Park Visitor Center showcases clothing, daily objects, and artifacts reflecting traditional Nez Perce ways of life, offering a glimpse into their rich cultural heritage.

Nestled within **Nez Perce National Historical Park** (Spalding, ID, 10 miles east of Lewiston; 208.843.7009; [nps.gov/nepe](https://www.nps.gov/nepe)), the Visitor Center stands as a gateway to a rich tapestry of Nez Perce heritage. Step inside, and you'll find a captivating collection of clothing and everyday objects that offer a glimpse into the traditional ways of Nez Perce life. Among the treasures is a ribbon, a tangible link to history, bestowed upon a tribal member by the Lewis and Clark Expedition. Surrounding the Center, a harmonious blend of nature and history awaits, with a tranquil picnic area, a vibrant arboretum, and the evocative Spalding townsite—all just a short stroll away.

For a more immersive experience into the Nimiipuu way of life, **Nez Perce Tourism** (800 Main Street Suite 2, Lewiston, ID; 208.790.8873; nezpercetourism.com) welcomes visitors with interactive storytelling, songs, drumming, and dance. From river beds to mountain tops, their land and water journeys offer a profound connection to the cultural heritage of Nimiipuu Country.

A WALK THROUGH HISTORY: MUSEUMS AND TOURS

The Lewis-Clark Valley is a haven for history enthusiasts, with museums and tours that vividly bring the past to life. **Idaho History Tours** (208.790.1257; idahohistorytours.com) take you beneath the sidewalks, revealing the hidden stories of the 1930s. The **Nez Perce County Historical Society Museum & Idaho's First Territorial Capitol** (3rd and Capital St., Lewiston, ID; 208.743.2535; nezpercecountymuseum.com) preserves 150 years of the county's history, housed in a historical campus with a beautiful historic house and replica capitol building and offers a turn-of-the-century Chinese Beuke Aie Temple.

Across the river in Asotin, the **Asotin County Museum** (215 Filmore Street, Asotin, WA; 509.243.4659; asotincountymuseum.org) offers an authentic glimpse into frontier life as settlers experienced it. Housed in a cement block building originally built as a funeral parlor in 1920, this museum features fascinating hands-on exhibits that invite visitors to engage with the past. The museum became home to the Asotin County Historical Society in 1972 and continues to preserve local history.

At the **Lewis-Clark Discovery Center at Hells Gate State Park** (5100 Hells Gate State Rd.; Lewiston, ID; 208.799.5015; parksandrecreation.idaho.gov/parks/hells-gate), interpretive displays, including an Indian tepee and dugout canoe, provide insights into the region's rich cultural history. Enjoy a 30-minute video, "Lewis & Clark: From the Mountains to the Sea," and explore the nearby trails for horseback riding, mountain biking, hiking, and scenic views of the Snake River.

The **Jack O'Connor Hunting Heritage & Education Center** (5600 Hells Gate Rd.; Lewiston, ID; 208.743.5043; jack-oconnor.org) stands as a testament to the passion and legacy of renowned sportsman Jack O'Connor. This center serves as the permanent residence for the O'Connor wildlife collection, a treasure trove of stunning wildlife trophies acquired from various corners of the globe.

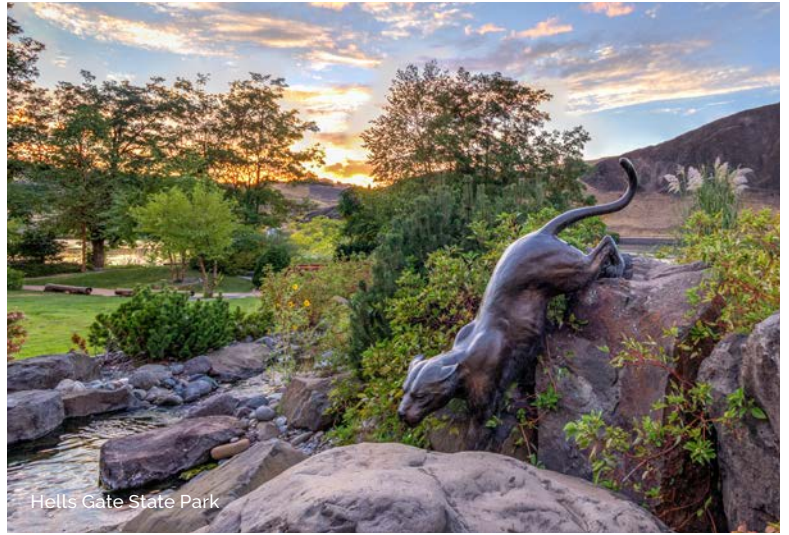

The **Tscemicum Sculpture**, situated on the Lewiston side of the confluence of the Clearwater and Snake rivers, emerges as a testament to Nez Perce mythology. This powerful sculpture, interpreting the Earth Mother figure sustaining all forms of life, reinforces the deep connection between art and the natural surroundings.

Venturing into **Chief Timothy Park** (13766 US-12, Clarkston, WA; confluenceproject.org), the **Listening Circle**, envisioned by renowned artist Maya Lin, invites contemplation amid the serene sounds of the breeze and water. This experiential artwork encapsulates the enduring spirit of the landscape, creating a tranquil haven for reflection.

Downtown Lewiston emerges as a dynamic canvas for contemporary expressions of public art. The fountain in front of the Lewiston City Library, artistic benches and bike racks, the playful canoe wave, and the captivating mosaics adorning the 5th Street pedestrian bridge are testament to the evolving cultural identity of the city.

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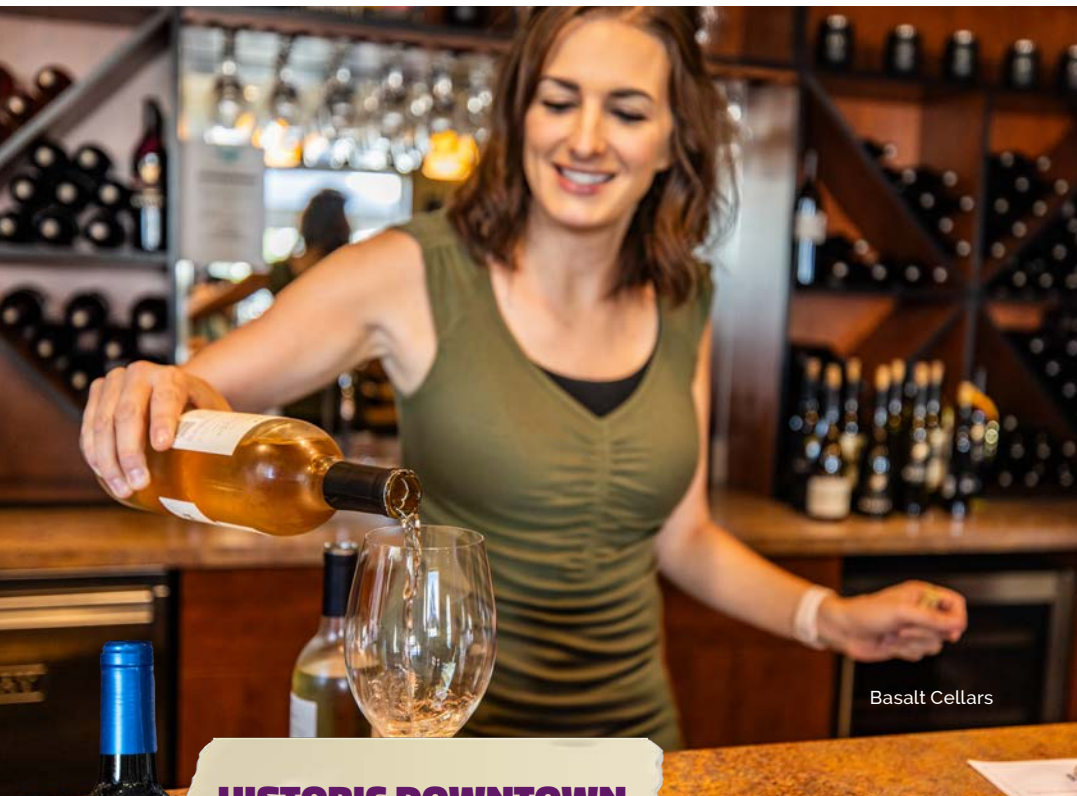
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SAVOR THE LEWIS-CLARK VALLEY AVA
