- DL** You can find high-quality oil & vinegar on tap here along with other gourmet food items.
- DL** The best organic coffee, scones, quiche and local wine located in an eclectic bohemian style historic building. You'll light up when you locate it.
- DL** At this shop you can "put the cat in the bag" to find high-end clothing and lifestyle boutique.
- LO** Harvest your own organic locally grown whole grains while enjoying a glass of their wine.
- DC** An old fashioned soda fountain with homemade pies, milkshakes, local gifts, souvenirs and the best caramel corn in town.
- DC** You can find a book worm or two here purchasing reads by local historians and authors.
- L** This Clearwater River gift shop has casino logo apparel, Nez Perce Tribal blankets, jewelry and more.

- DL** "Humuhumunukunukuapau'a"
- DL** This bakery features mouth watering treats and gluten-free items baked throughout the day.
- DL** You'll be a little more "jolly" after enjoying menu features of traditional American and classic French cuisines at this restaurant.
- DC** You can put out your "fire" for hunger out at this restaurant with freshly made home-cooking and cocktails.
- DC** Originally a tavern and sporting good store, this pub is now home to delicious food, friendly service and the best house-made craft cocktails in town.
- 21** A Bistro named after the famous explorer of the Lewis and Clark Trail - "Captain Lewis."
- DL** While cruising Main Street you'll want to stop in here for their juicy burgers, signatures sandwiches and homemade soups.
- DL** A Café that has insights to mysteries on their menu with skillfully-crafted cuisine from locally sourced ingredients.
- CW** A relaxing lounge alongside the water makes the perfect hideaway on the river. A dynamic seasonal menu at the Holiday Inn.
- CW** Hit the deck at this one-of-a-kind waterfront restaurant with an uber-cool bar with 18 regional microbrews on tap.
- L** You have to head south to find this pizzeria dedicated to using only the freshest ingredients.
- LO** This bar & grill is famous for their giant sandwiches and homemade turkey noodle soup—it's definitely a strike for the win.
- DC** A family-style Italian restaurant with a wood-fired brick oven and sports lounge.
- L** This family-friendly restaurant features a Zushi bar and serves up an eclectic menu and homemade milkshakes.
- C** Fore! You'll find this restaurant at the Red Wolf Golf Club.

WINERIES / MICROBREWS

- DL** Located in a haunted former bordello, both the building and wines have a jovial flare full of character and intrigue.
- LO** Expect to be impressed—this winery was named Wine Press Northwest's 2020 Pacific NW Winery of the Year!
- J** You'll find this winery on the creek named after one of the Lewis & Clark explorers (hint: first name John). It's also Wine Press Northwest's 2020 Idaho Winery of the Year!
- CW** Handcrafted award-winning premium wines named after the famous Basalt columns in our region.
- LO** This winery, named after a creek, produces premium wines on a 4th generation wheat farm.
- DC** This winery produces high-quality Spanish varietal wines.
- J** Located at the mouth of the Potlatch and Clearwater Rivers with amazing views and wines.
- LO** This award-winning Tammany view wineries passion lies in their love for good wine where there is always room for one more dog.
- DL** This winery was named after the 46th Parallel North where their grapes are grown for their boutique wines.
- L** You'll have to do some groundwork to find this gem serving hand-picked beers, sours, ciders, local wines and brick oven pizzas!
- L** "Hop" on into this brew house with the largest selection of wine and beer on tap with a large patio. They pair perfectly with their delicious food.
- CW** Brewing their own handcrafted ales in their laid-back tap room and large deck near the river port district. Serving local wine and appetizers.
- SH** The vista and views are worthy of the drive to this location where you can enjoy local wines and microbrews. Open Fridays from 4—9pm.
- SH** Spiral your way up the highway to find this winery with a spectacular views and a glass of Kombucha or wine (by appointment only).
- L** You'll feel like you're back in the stadium at this sports bar featuring games and video walls of sporting events.
